Product Description

HEALTH DATA

- The product has no significant toxic hazard.
- Small amounts of Hazardous fumes are produced by combustion or high temperature decomposition.

EXPOSURE

- **Skin:** Flush skin thoroughly with cool water if molten plastic contacts the skin.
- **Eye:** May irritate from physical contact.
- **Inhalation:** Remove to fresh air. If necessary seek medical advice.
- **Note to Physician:** Material has no significant toxic hazard.

EFFECTS OF OVER-EXPOSURE

- **Acute:** Material has no significant toxic hazard. Substance decomposes at high temperature, producing irritating and toxic fumes.
- **Chronic:** No significant toxic hazard.
- **Route:** Fumes from high temperature decomposition are irritating and molten material can burn the skin.
- **Toxicity:** Material has no significant toxic hazard.

FIRE EXTINGUISHING METHOD AND PROCEDURE

- **Method:** Extinguish using water or dry chemical.
- **Procedure:** Use water or other extinguishing medium appropriate for surrounding fires. Care should be taken as all fires liberate toxic gases.
- **Hazard:** Decomposition by burning in open flame may yield carbon dioxide, carbon monoxide, as well as small quantities of other organic chemicals.

INGREDIANTS

Polyethylene: Under normal use, this material does not release, or otherwise result in exposure to a hazardous chemical.

HANDLING & STORAGE

Store in a cool dry place away from direct UV light.
